1. Introduction

2. Definitions

To help You understand this Cookie Policy clearly, the following defined terms are used throughout:

Cookie or Cookies mean small data files that are transferred to Your computer or mobile device when You browse the Website. Cookies enable us to remember Your account log-in information, IP addresses, web traffic, number of times You visit, browser type and version, device details, and date and time of visits.

DPO means Data Protection Officer of LECS

User or You or Your means an individual who visits our Website

3. How We Use Cookies

LECS uses Cookies to identify Users on our Website. Cookies may also be used by other third-party websites where You access third-party links through our Website. Cookies enable us to make Your User experience easier, customise our features, services, content, and advertising; help You ensure that Your account security is not compromised, mitigate risk and prevent fraud; and to promote trust and safety.

When You visit the Website, Cookies allow our servers to remember Your account log-in information, IP addresses, date and time of visits, monitor traffic, and prevent fraudulent activities.

We have no control over the Cookies used by third-party links, and we always advise that You read the cookie policy and privacy notice before accepting such cookies.

4. The Types Of Cookies We Use

We use the following Cookies:

Own Cookies: these are those sent to the User's terminal from a computer or domain managed by us and from which the service requested by the User is provided.

Necessary Cookies: these are Cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, Cookies that enable You to visit the Website and make use of any of the features on the Website.

Analytical or Performance Cookies: these allow us to recognise and count the number of Users or visits to the Website, and to see how Users move around the Website when it is being used. This helps us to improve the way our Website works by ensuring that Users can easily access our services and features.

Functionality Cookies: these are Cookies which continue to store data on the User's terminal and such data can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the controller of the Cookies. These Cookies are used to recognise You when You return to our Website. This enables us to personalise Your experience and remember Your preferences, and the choices You make on the Website (for example, Your choice of language or region).

Session cookies: these are designed to collect and store information while the User is accessing the Website. These Cookies are not stored on the User's computer when the session expires, or the browser is closed.

Technical cookies: these enable the User to browse the web page, and use the different options or service on it, e.g. to log into secure areas of our Website, to access restricted web site areas, to make a subscription or an application to participate in an event, to use security elements during browsing, to store content to broadcast videos or sound or to share content over the social networks

5. How To Disable Cookies

Some browsers may automatically accept Cookies while some can be modified to decline Cookies or alert You when a website wants to place a Cookie on Your computer. You can block Cookies by activating the setting on Your browser that allows You to refuse the setting of all or some Cookies. However, if You use Your browser to block Cookies (including necessary cookies), You may not be able to access all or parts of our Website.

We may make changes to this Cookie Policy from time to time as may be required.
